



Munroe Transportation Rules

Student safety is of the utmost importance. All passengers must abide by the following rules, as well as any directions given by the driver. Bus/van drivers have the same authority in their vehicles as teachers in their classrooms. Students must abide by the following rules:

1. **MOST IMPORTANT!** Everyone must wear a seatbelt at all times.
2. Before crossing the roadway, ensure the road is clear in both directions.
3. Stay in your seat at all times
4. There will be **NO** video games allowed. iPads with headphones are permitted.
5. No elementary students are permitted past the last emergency exit.
6. Talk quietly. Do not talk as directed by the driver, when approaching railroad crossings, when approaching accidents, or when sirens are heard. Do not talk or shout through the windows.
7. Keep arms and heads inside the windows.
8. Do not throw trash on the floor or out the windows. Do not mark, deface, or damage the vehicles.
9. In order to provide appropriate safety, the driver may assign seats.
10. No eating or drinking at any time.
11. Be on time! The bus will not wait for passengers. Assemble before the bus arrives. Do not wait in the car or home. Do NOT run or drive after the bus if you miss it or attempt to beat the bus to the next bus stop.
12. Tampering with emergency exits will result in immediate suspension.
13. Be aware that all rules pertaining to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, fighting, and weapons on campus also apply to Munroe vehicles.
14. When you know ahead of time that your child will not be riding the bus, please let your driver know.
