#### **Kindergarten - 2nd Grade**

Drop Off Window - 7:45 - 8:00

School Day - 8:00 - 3:00

Pick-Up - 3:00 - 3:15

Aftercare - 3:15 - 5:45

#### **3rd Grade - 5th Grade**

Drop Off Window - 8:00 - 8:20

School Day - 8:20 - 3:15

Pick-Up - 3:15 - 3:30

Aftercare - 3:30 - 5:45

If you are unable to pick up your child by the designated time, they can attend aftercare. Aftercare hours are 3:15 - 5:45 and you will be charged a small fee. This is a safe place for your child to do homework and have social activities with other students.
