

Robert F. Munroe Day School 2022-2023 Admissions Standards

The Robert F. Munroe sets a standard for admission that is designed to admit students that have the greatest chance of success. Students are evaluated on the following criteria:

- 1. Interview
- 2. Writing sample
- 3. Testing Scores
- 4. Grades
- 5. Shadowing
- 6. Previous School Recommendation

For interviews, the school is looking for students that have age-appropriate social and language skills, express a desire to learn, and have areas of interest that they can discuss. For the writing sample, the student should be able to write at an age-appropriate level as compared to other students of the same age group. Students submitting grades should demonstrate a stable level of achievement by taking appropriate classes. Whenever possible students will participate in classes and demonstrate basic academic skills such as being able to answer questions, complete assignments, work in groups, and listen to the teacher. Finally, whenever possible, the former school is contacted and the academic and behavior records are reviewed.
